Richelieu Bush Vine Dry Grow GCM IGP Pays Du Gers, France A superb southern French red, with one eye on the Rhone Valley and on the cutting edge wines of this region. Hedgerow fruits, a gentle yet fine tannin backbone, with juicy fruits throughout, a great complex wine.	£3.10	£4.50	£6.20	£17.50
Euca Hill Shiraz 2017 South Eastern Australia Medium bodied with baked black plums and bramble fruit and soft tannins.	£3.20	£4.75	£6.40	£18.50
Liso Veinte Tempranillo 2017 Bodegas Agronavarra, Spain An attractive and fruity red. Medium bodied with notes of dill, mushroom and red fruits. There is cranberry, raspberry and redcurrant on the palate with a firm tannin finish.	£3.10	£4.55	£6.20	£17.95
Vistamar Brisa Cabernet Sauvignon 2017 Central Valley, Chile Smooth and rounded with great fruit expression in the mouth of blackberries, plums and black cherries beautifully blended with touches of vanilla.	£3.10	£4.55	£6.20	£17.95
Tonada Merlot 2018 Central Valley Chile Hints of smoky plum and damson jam on the nose. A fruity, medium bodied palate with more plum flavours, a chocolatey note and a twist of spice.	£3.55	£5.30	£7.10	£21.00

Drakensberg Cinsaut-Cabernet Sauvignon 2013 Paarl, South Africa Soft and fruity, easy drinking red. On the nose there are strawberry tones and hints of tobacco leaf while the palate is medium bodied and smooth with a touch of spice from oak ageing.				£19.55
Lautarul Pinot Noir Romania Dark in colour, fruit cake and spicy aromatics. Beautiful flavours, almost syrupy in its concentration. Layers of complex black cherry, raspberry and cinnamon, with a long and lingering finish.				£19.95

Deakin Estate Shiraz 2017 Deakin Estate, Victoria, Australia 100% Shiraz Good punchy Shiraz aromas of mulberry and plum, supported by hints of vanilla and coffee. The palate is juicy, spicy and satisfying, with a rounded finish.	£25.00
Miopasso Primitivo IGP 2017 Puglia, Italy Benchmark Primitivo, bigger and robust, but not too full, and still smooth and silky. A rich spicy warming red with flavours of prunes, cherries and herbal notes. Plenty of ripe dark berry flavours.	£23.00
Salice Salentino Borgo Riserva, Cantine Paolo Leo (Negroamora/Malvasia Nero) 2010 Puglia, Italy Very deep ruby colour, black at the core. The nose is very ripe and rich, with blackberry, dark cherry and espresso notes. The palate is full bodied, yet retains fine balancing acidity and finishes with warmth and ripe tannins. Powerful but with elegance.	£27.00
Régnié Domaine des Buyats, (Beaujolais Villages) 2013 Georges Duboeuf, Beaujolais, France A bright, medium-bodied style from this Cru Beaujolais, with juicy cherry fruit, violet nuances, and a bit of spice, enjoy slightly chilled!	£25.00
Mas des Bressades (Syrah/Grenache) 2016 Costières de Nîmes, Languedoc Roussillon, France Fresh black pepper and the herbs of the garrigue combine in this juicy, berry-charged wine. Long, stylish stuff, highly recommended!	£25.00
Montepulciano d'abruzzo Taverna Nova, Roxan, 2016 Abruzzo, Italy A vibrant, deep-purple colour. This wine displays rich, luscious cherry fruit with a warm, lingering finish.	£26.00
Rioja Vega Crianza 2015 Spain A very velvety wine on the palate with a great structure and fruity expression. Twelve months ageing in oak has given greater depth and flavour to the wine.	£32.00
“Campofiorin” Rosso del Veronese IGT 2015 Masi, Veneto, Italy “Essentially a baby Amarone for half the price”! Attractive, aromatic nose dominated by cherries and spice. Well-balanced, full-bodied palate with notes of ripe red fruit, cherry liqueur and blueberries. Long aftertaste with hints of vanilla and cocoa. Masi are quite simply the best producer of Amarone and Amarone style wines in the region today. The wines are made using some grapes that have been left to dry until the flavours are highly concentrated and then pressed and blended with the main wine. Highly recommended!	£32.00

Campo Nuevo Rosado 2017 Navarra, Spain The nose has aromas of strawberry, raspberry and redcurrant. There is a subtle creamy edge on the palate and its very well balanced and tasty in the mouth.	£3.40	£5.00	£6.40	£20.00
Rosé D'anjou, les Roseraies, Drouet Frères 2017 La Chapelle – Heulin, France Salmon pink hue and a beautiful intensity. The nose is reminiscent of red berries. An expressive, rich and aromatic palate with a hint of liquorice and toffee. The clear, fresh and tasty finish is balanced by a fine acidity.				£25.00
