IGP Pays du Gers, France

Aromatic, tropical and citrus fruit flavours with a fruity finish.

Kleindal Chenin Blanc 2018 £3.10 £4.50 £6.20 £17.50

Robertson Valley, South Africa

South Africa's most popular white grape. Lovely fruity and refreshing taste with subtle notes of fruit salad and white stone fruit with a textured, well-rounded palate. There is fresh, balancing acidity and papaya and mango on the finish.

La Petite Perriere Sauvignon Blanc 2017 £3.80 £5.70 £7.60 £22.50

Loire Valley, France

The nose is elegant with harmonious expression of white flowers, elderflower, acacia.

After a silky attack, the mid-palate shows savoury freshness with notes of white peach and lychee fruit.

Pure Pinot Grigio delle Venezie IGT £3.40 £5.00 £6.80 £20.00

Friuli-Venezia-Giulia, Italy

A textbook example of good quality Pinot Grigio - Pear and apple combined with citrus on a dry, refreshing palate.

Bon Courage Estate wine, unwooded Chardonnay 2018 £3.60 £5.30 £7.20 £21.00

Robertson Valley, South Africa

Showing fullness on the palate with more citrus and lime flavours finishing with a clean, lemon zest mouthfeel.

Rioja Vega Blanco 2017 £3.90 £5.80 £7.80 £23.00

Rioja, Spain

The nose has aromas of pear, white flowers and some limey notes. Fresh, clean and crisp in the mouth with good length and balance. As white Rioja goes this is a simple, unoaked style that's fresh and vibrant.

Escapada Vinho Verde 2017 £19.00

Portugal

Made from this region's traditional varieties (Trajadura, Loureiro, Arinto and Avesso). It is a fresh, fruity, light and mineral wine. It can be drunk on it's own or ideal to side with fish, seafood and salads.

Törley Grüner Veltliner 2017 £22.00

Toaky, Hungary

Dry in style, this Grüner Veltliner has bright aromas of citrus fruit and green herbs balanced with white pepper and warm spice.

Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine la Serre 2018 £23.30

Languedoc-Roussillon, France

Crisp and dry on the palate with additional notes of peach and melon, there is a backbone of intense minerality and a zippy, clean acidity that work together to deliver a long refreshing finish. Can be served as an apéritif or as a fine accompaniment to seafood and fish.

<p>Domaine de la Baume Viognier 2017 Languedoc-Roussillon, France</p> <p>Notes of fresh apricot and white peach, on the palate full and savoury with a hint of white pepper. Can be enjoyed as an aperitif, or with Asian flavours, fish cooked in sauce and white meats.</p>	£25.80
<p>Fiano, Carlomagno Puglia, Italy 2017</p> <p>Straw yellow shot with green; very full and intensely fruity on the nose with exotic fruit such as melon and banana, featuring hints of citrus reminiscent of grapefruit. On the palate it is very well balanced, with a good acidity backbone and length. A superb accompaniment to shellfish, fish and seafood. Pair also with white meat and cheese.</p>	£26.00
<p>Dopff & Irion Riesling 2016 Alsace, France</p> <p>Pale-yellow colour. Fresh with white flowers and slightly mineral. Well balanced, with a good weight. Citrus and green apple aromas and a hint of mineral. A Riesling with a nice fruitiness and good body. Very easily enjoyed.</p>	£29.00
<p>Babich Black label Sauvignon Blanc 2017 Marlborough, New Zealand</p> <p>A blend of wine from the estate-owned vineyards which, while displaying the pungent and crisp characteristics that set Marlborough sourced fruit apart, shows greater depth and complexion on the palate.</p>	£30.00
<p>Chablis – Domaine “Ste Claire” 2017 Domaine J-M Brocard, Burgundy, France</p> <p>100% Unoaked Chardonnay</p> <p>The nose is precise, pure and mineral, with additional notes of citrus. The palate is classic Chablis: structured, crisp and delicious, with flavours echoing the nose.</p>	£32.00
