### White Wines

Richelieu Unoaked Colombard Ugni Blanc £3.10 £4.50 £6.20 £17.50

IGP Pays du Gers, France

Aromatic, tropical and citrus fruit flavours with a fruity finish.

Kleindal Chenin Blanc 2019 £3.10 £4.50 £6.20 £17.50

Robertson Valley, South Africa

South Africa's most popular white grape. Lovely fruity and refreshing taste with subtle notes of fruit salad and white stone fruit with a textured, well-rounded palate. There is fresh, balancing acidity and papaya and mango on the finish.

La Petite Perriere Sauvignon Blanc 2019 £3.80 £5.70 £7.60 £22.50

Loire Valley, France

The nose is elegant without over-exuberance, a fair and harmonious expression of white flowers, elderflowers and acacia, balanced with a light minerality. After a silky attack, the middle of the palate wakes up in a pleasant freshness, finishing with fruity notes of white peaches and lychees

Pure Pinot Grigio delle Venezie IGT £3.40 £5.00 £6.80 £20.00

Friuli-Venezia-Giulia, Italy

A textbook example of good quality Pinot Grigio - Pear and apple combined with citrus on a dry, refreshing palate.

Bon Courage Estate wine, unwooded Chardonnay 2019 £3.60 £5.30 £7.20 £21.00

Robertson Valley, South Africa

This Chardonnay shows scents of tropical like guava, also limes and a hint of pineapple. The palate is supple, dry and smooth, the aromas are reflected in the long-lasting finale.

Rioja Vega Blanco 2019 £3.90 £5.80 £7.80 £23.00

Rioja, Spain

The nose has aromas of pear, white flowers and some limey notes. Fresh, clean and crisp in the mouth with good length and balance. As white Rioja goes this is a simple, unoaked style that's fresh and vibrant.

Escapada Vinho Verde 2019 £19.00

Portugal

Made from this region's traditional varieties (Trajadura, Loureiro, Arinto and Avesso). A restrained nose of pear and banana with lemon rind, apples and herbs on the palate along with a suggestion of light spritz on the finish. This is crunchy, crisp and refreshing. Perfect as an aperitif or with seafood or white fish.

Törley Grüner Veltliner 2018 £22.00

Toaky, Hungary

Dry in style, this Grüner Veltliner has bright aromas of citrus fruit and green herbs balanced with white pepper and warm spice.

<p>Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine la Serre 2018 Languedoc-Roussillon, France</p> <p>Crisp and dry on the palate with additional notes of peach and melon, there is a backbone of intense minerality and a zippy, clean acidity that work together to deliver a long refreshing finish. Can be served as an apéritif or as a fine accompaniment to seafood and fish.</p>	£23.30
<p>Domaine de la Baume Viognier 2019 Languedoc-Roussillon, France</p> <p>An elegant and complex 100% Viognier aromatic with orange blossom florals and soft baking spicy aromas on the nose. Dry, full-bodied with ripe stone-fruit, lemon meringue flavours finishing zesty on the palate. Can be enjoyed as an aperitif, or with Asian flavours, fish cooked in sauce and white meats.</p>	£25.80
<p>Fiano, Carlomagno Puglia, Italy 2018</p> <p>Straw yellow shot with green; very full and intensely fruity on the nose with exotic fruit such as melon and banana, featuring hints of citrus reminiscent of grapefruit. On the palate it is very well balanced, with a good acidity backbone and length. A superb accompaniment to shellfish, fish and seafood. Pair also with white meat and cheese.</p>	£26.00
<p>Dopff &amp; Irion Riesling 2018 Alsace, France</p> <p>Pale straw in colour. Fresh, with white flowers and a slight mineral, gun flint character giving real charm. Well balanced, with good weight, citrus and green apple flavours and a hint of minerality. A Riesling with a delicious fruitiness and good body. Very enjoyable.</p>	£29.00
<p>Babich Black label Sauvignon Blanc 2019 Marlborough, New Zealand</p> <p>A blend of wine from the estate-owned vineyards. Perfumed and pungent with blackcurrant, passionfruit and a hint of mace. A dense and textural palate with lime and mandarin, kiwifruit and green apple. Fruit concentration provides focus and length. Spicy on finish.</p>	£30.00
<p>Chablis, Domaine Testut 2018 Burgundy, France</p> <p>Tight, mineral and intense with a steely structure. Another great Chablis from this renowned producer.</p>	£33.00
